Festival of Ice—Juniata River Valley, Lewistown

The Festival of Ice was on Thursday, Nov 30 and Friday, Dec 1. The theme this year was Christmas Island, a tropical Christmas. It took a little bit of preparation, which our son, Matt, volunteered by packing 1,000 packets with many CEF goodies in them. Inside the packets, we had things that we hoped would get the kids involved in various ways in CEF, such as Mailbox club, Tel-A-Story, U-nite, and Meet the King pamphlet. We also attached an invitation to a Christmas Party, to be held on Dec 15, in one of our Released Time churches.

The first night at the festival, Joe and I walked around with a wagon filled with packets to pass out to the children. The second night we had a booth set up and were able to talked to many parents. Linda McCaulley and two of her granddaughters took the wagon and passed out more packets. Because it had rained on the second night, a little before the Ice Festival, it was chilly and not as many people attended. God was good though because He held off the rain during the night when the festival was going on.
